2025 was a strong and impactful year for our organisation, marked by continued growth and an expansion in the reach of our charitable work. Our total income increased from £687,000 to £820,000—an uplift of approximately 19.4%—reflecting the trust, generosity, and ongoing support of our donors.

Throughout the year, we invested over £600,000 in life-saving and community-focused projects, with the majority of funds directed to frontline work in Bangladesh and East Africa. These efforts enabled us to support vulnerable families and communities through a wide range of initiatives, including clean water projects, shelter and housing, healthcare services, education, Masjid and Madrasah construction, wheelchair distributions, family food packs, and livelihood support such as rickshaws and sewing machines.

Looking ahead, we are committed to making 2026 an even more impactful year. Insha'Allah, we aim to build upon our progress by expanding our work into additional African countries while strengthening our existing programmes. We humbly ask for your continued support and prayers as we strive to reach more vulnerable communities and deliver sustainable, life-changing projects.

In 2025, we spent over £600,000 across a wide range of projects in Bangladesh and Tanzania, demonstrating our continued commitment to delivering impactful, community-focused development.

HOUSING PROJECT

A safe and secure home is the foundation of a dignified life. For vulnerable families, it provides not only shelter, but also security, stability, and renewed hope for the future.

Housing remains one of our core flagship programmes. Following the devastating floods of 2022, the need for safe and permanent housing has increased significantly, with many families still living without adequate shelter.

In 2025, we continued to prioritise housing support for families most affected by flooding and emergency situations. Looking ahead to 2026, we aim to expand this work further by constructing additional homes for the most vulnerable and needy households.

With the continued support of our donors, we remain committed to transforming lives by providing families with safe, peaceful homes and a foundation for a more secure future.

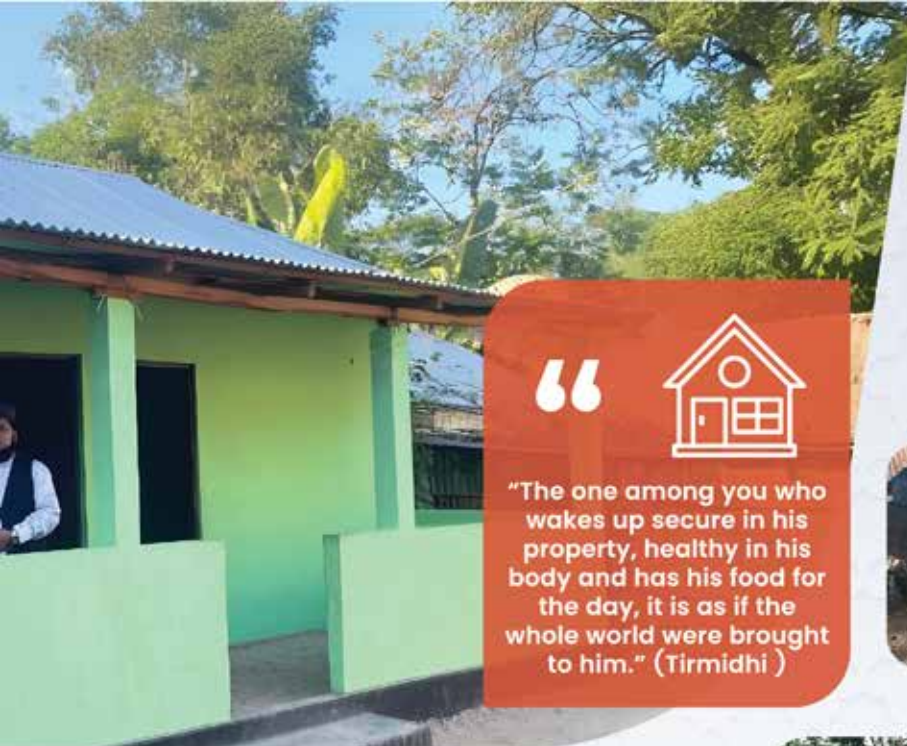

MASJID PROJECT

Masjids are the heart of the Muslim community—places of prayer, remembrance, learning, and unity, where believers gather to worship Allah and strengthen their faith.

Building and maintaining masjids carries immense reward in Islam. Yet, for communities in poor or remote areas, constructing a permanent masjid is extremely difficult. Many villages still rely on temporary structures, small rooms, or unsafe spaces that cannot accommodate worshippers safely. Without a proper masjid, communities miss out on a central place for worship, learning, and communal support.

Each permanent masjid serves an average of 120–150 worshippers, providing a lasting center for prayer and community life. Your support—whether individual or collective—helps communities establish a permanent house of Allah and share in the ongoing reward of Sadaqah Jariyah.

WATER PROJECT

Water is one of the greatest gifts of Allah and the foundation of life itself. Yet millions of people around the world still struggle to access clean, safe drinking water—a daily challenge that affects health, education, and livelihoods.

Since 2007, with the support of our donors, we have helped communities gain access to their own sources of clean water, completing more than 3,500 wells across Bangladesh. These wells have transformed lives, providing life-saving water to entire villages.

Water scarcity remains a serious problem. In Tanzania, many communities still lack reliable water sources, while in Bangladesh, dropping traditional tube wells ineffective. In response, we provide both tube wells and deep tube wells, tailored to each community's needs, ensuring safe, sustainable access to clean water for generations.

Supporting water projects is one of the most rewarding forms of Sadaqah Jariyah, as each well brings health, life, and lasting benefit to entire communities. With your continued support, more families can drink safely, stay healthy, and thrive.

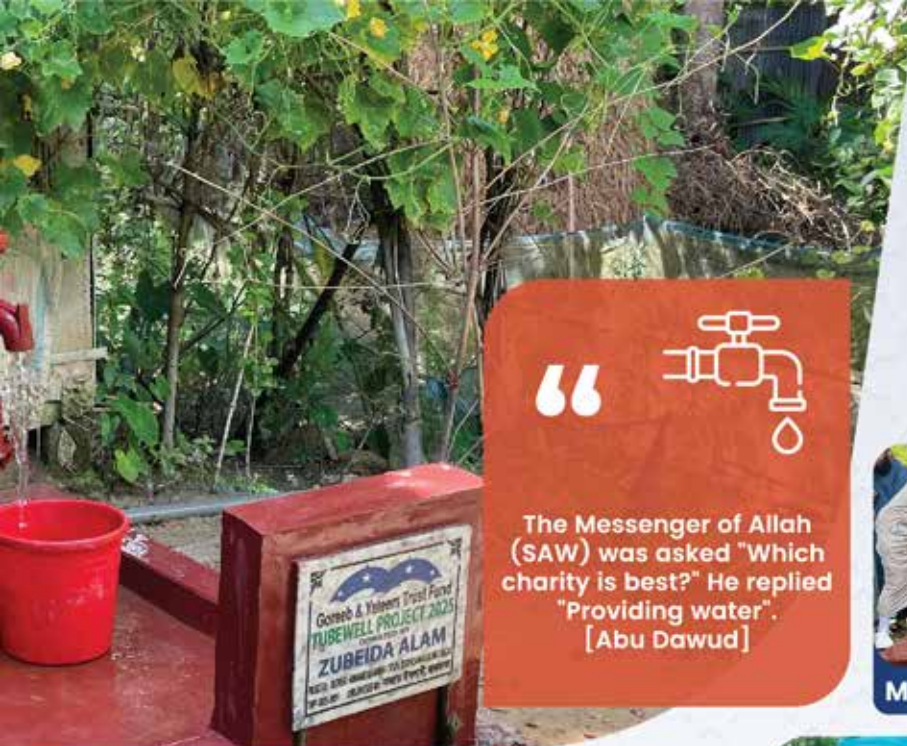

FAMILY EMPOWERMENT

Many families lack the basic tools and assets needed to earn a living and support their children. Without these essentials, escaping poverty is extremely difficult.

The Family Empowerment Project helps vulnerable families achieve self-reliance with dignity. By providing essential tools and equipment, families can generate income without the burden of renting or leasing, creating sustainable livelihoods for themselves and their children.

Alhamdulillah, with the support of our donors, we have distributed:

- 590 rickshaws
- 1,244 sewing machines
- 215 fishing boats
- 210 thelaghari

Each asset represents a long-term source of income and a life-changing opportunity. Supporting family empowerment is an investment in self-reliance, dignity, and lasting change for generations to come.

Even though 2025 saw no major natural disasters, the effects of previous crises continue to impact many families. Recovery is often slow, especially for those starting with very little. With the support of our donors, we were able to assist thousands of people, protecting their health and giving hope for a better future.

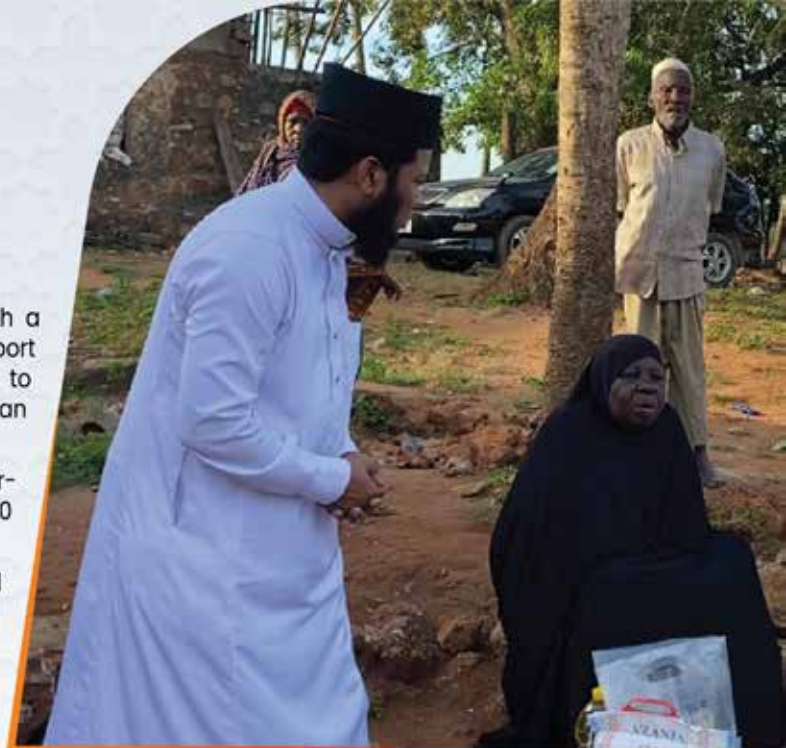
EAST AFRICA – TANZANIA

Alhamdulillah, in 2025 we made significant progress in East Africa, with a strong focus on Tanzania—a country where the need for basic support remains profound. Many communities continue to face hardships due to poverty, lack of infrastructure, and limited access to essentials like clean water, shelter, and healthcare.

With the generosity of our donors, we were able to make a tangible difference: 20 Masjids built, 4 deep water wells installed, 4 homes constructed, 100 wheelchairs distributed and over 100 food packs distributed.

These interventions have not only provided clean water, shelter, food, and mobility but have also restored dignity, hope, and stability to struggling communities.

Tanzania remains one of the regions where our work is most crucial. Our mission is far from over, and with your continued support, we can expand our impact, uplift more families, and create lasting, meaningful change.



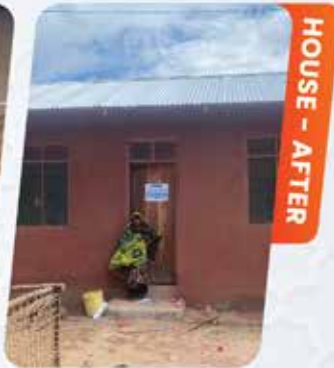
